Caramel Coconut Slice

Ingredients

2 tbsp golden syrup ½cup plain flour
½ cup SR flour ½ cup desiccated coconut
½cup caster sugar 100g melted unsalted butter
385g can sweetened condensed milk
¼ cup brown sugar, firmly packed
60g melted unsalted butter
4 eggs, lightly beaten
⅔ cup caster sugar
2 cups desiccated coconut
2 cups shredded coconut



Method:

* Preheat oven to 180°. Grease and line a rectangle slice pan.

Base:

* In a mixing bowl, combine the flours, coconut, sugar and 100g melted butter. Press the mixture evenly across the slice pan.

* Bake for 10 mins or until the base is lightly golden. Remove from the oven and set aside to cool.

Mixture and Topping:

* Meanwhile, combine the condensed milk, golden syrup, brown sugar and 60g melted butter to make a caramel in a small bowl.

* Combine the eggs, sugar & both types of coconut together in a small bowl.

* Once the base has cooled, pour the caramel onto the base and spread it evenly.

* Add the coconut topping over the caramel & spread evenly.

* Bake for 20-25 mins, or until the coconut topping is golden brown.
