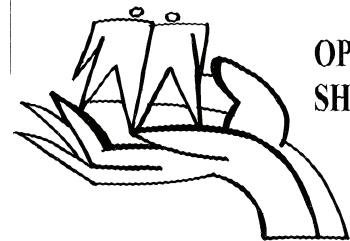

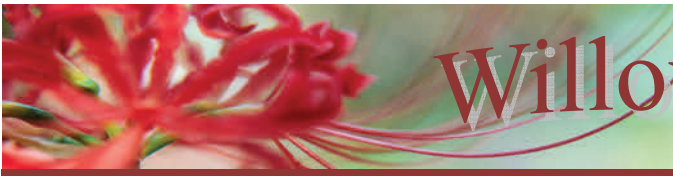

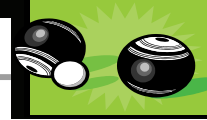

The fun will begin at 1pm - all welcome.

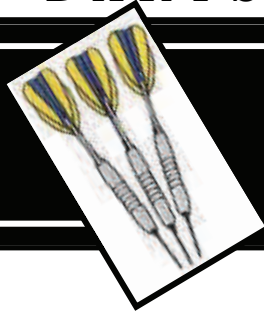

# *Polenta, Capsicum and Sweet-Potato Muffins*

Serves: 12

## INGREDIENTS

- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup wholemeal self-raising flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup self-raising flour
- $\frac{2}{3}$  cup polenta
- 2 tablespoons fresh chives
- 2 tablespoons fresh parsley
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup chopped red capsicum
- 250 grams sweet potato, peeled and grated
- 1 egg
- 1 cup low-fat milk



## METHOD

Preheat oven to 200°C.

Beat the egg and milk together in a bowl, then set aside.

Combine all the other ingredients in a bowl, then mix the egg and milk mixture through the dry ingredients.

When everything is combined, spoon the mixture into a greased muffin tray. Cook for 15-20 minutes, or until golden.

## **WILLOW LODGE GATE OPERATION**

The front gates will remain open from 6.00am in the morning to 7.00pm at night. During 7.00pm at night to 6.00am in the morning the following will apply.

When leaving Willow Lodge you must drive up to the gates and wait until the gates are fully open and then drive out. **ONLY ONE CAR AT A TIME MAY EXIT WILLOW LODGE.**

### **ENTERING WILLOW LODGE BY CAR**

When entering Willow Lodge the gate can be opened by one of two ways.

#### **BY CARD**

This is done by driving up to the intercom and passing your card in front of the red light above the intercom. This will open the gate, remember **ONLY ONE CAR AT A TIME MAY ENTER WILLOW LODGE.**

#### **BY THE INTERCOM**

If you have visitors coming to visit you, they must drive up to the intercom and enter the last four digits of the residents phone number, followed by the **#Button**.

The intercom will then ring the residents phone, once the resident has spoken to the person, the resident must then push the following number into their phone **#16482**. This will open the gate, remember **ONLY ONE CAR AT A TIME MAY ENTER WILLOW LODGE.**

### **USING WILLOW LODGE PEDESTRIAN GATE**

If you are leaving Willow Lodge by Pedestrian gate you must press the button on the left hand side of the gate, and then pull the gate towards you when leaving.
